Parental Notification of Employee Misconduct

Senate Bill 571

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of an "education entity" must adopt a policy to provide notice to parents/guardians regarding employee misconduct, as prescribed by TEC § 22A.053.

Board Action Date:

Beginning of 2025-26 school year

Concussion Response Policy

Senate Bill 2398

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must adopt a policy addressing proper response to a concussion sustained by a student on school property or while participating in a non-UIL, school-sponsored or related activity, as required by TEC § 38.173.

Board Action Date:

Beginning of 2025-26 school year

Parental Engagement Policy

Senate Bill 12

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must develop a policy that satisfies the requirements of TEC § 26.0071, in furtherance of increased parental access and engagement in their child's education.

Prohibition Against DEI Practices

Senate Bill 12

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must adopt a policy in accordance with TEC § 11.005, addressing discipline of an employee or contractor who engages in or assigns to another person DEI practices or duties. A physical *and* electronic copy of the policy must be provided to each school employee or contractor.

Participation in UIL Activities by Non-Enrolled Students

Senate Bill 401

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school may adopt a policy to opt-out of allowing a homeschool or non-enrolled student to participate in UIL activities.

September 1, 2025 (otherwise the next date to adopt policy will be August 1, 2026)

School Health Advisory Councils (SHACs) for Charters

Senate Bill 12

Board Action Required:

Open-enrollment charter schools are now required to join their ISD counterparts and establish local School Health Advisory Councils (SHACs). The governing body of a charter school is required to appoint members of the SHAC to direct health education instruction in alignment with TEC § 28.004.

Restrictions on Vendor Contracts

House Bill 210

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must closely evaluate bids and contracts with current and future vendors and subcontractors. TEC § 11.067 broadly defines who constitutes a vendor and places significant restrictions on those relationships, including criminal penalties for vendors in violation.

Good Cause Exception Renewal (School Safety)

House Bill 121

Board Action Required:

Upon the first anniversary of the date in which a good cause exception was claimed for purposes of the armed security officer requirement, an ISD board of trustees or a governing body of a charter school must reevaluate and renew its good cause exception claim, in accordance with TEC § 37.0814(d-1).

September 1, 2025

Open Meetings Act Requirements

Multiple Bills

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must be in compliance with all applicable changes to the Open Meetings Act impacting meeting notices and posting requirements, both prior to and following regular and special meetings of the board. **Refer to SLHA Client Advisory for details.**

September 1, 2025

Personal Communication Device Ban

House Bill 1481

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must adopt a written policy prohibiting student use of a personal communication device while on school property during the school day and as further prescribed by TEC § 37.082.

September 18, 2025

Excused Absence for Released Time Course

Senate Bill 1049

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees and the governing body of a charter school must adopt a policy for excusing a student to attend a released time course, as prescribed by TEC § 25.0875. "Released time course" is defined as a course in religious instruction offered by a private entity.

Board Action Date:

January 1, 2026

Acquisition of Library Materials

Senate Bill 13

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees must adopt a policy regarding the acquisition of library materials, including procedures for procurement of library materials and receipt of donated materials, in accordance with TEC § 33.026.

Board Action Date:

Before first day of 2025-26 school year

Parental Involvement in Disciplinary Placements

House Bill 6

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees *may* adopt a policy addressing parental involvement in school disciplinary placements, as prescribed by TEC § 37.0014. The policy may include a behavioral agreement at the request of the parent.

Board Action Date:

Beginning of 2025-26 school year

Charters Exempt

Prohibition Against Assistance with Social Transitioning

Senate Bill 12

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees must adopt a policy prohibiting an employee from assisting a student with social transitioning, including providing information or guidance, in accordance with TEC § 11.401. The board must investigate any alleged violations under the policy and report substantiated violations to TEA.

Board Action Date:

September 1, 2025

Charters Exempt

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees must develop a policy reflective of the very-detailed, updated grievance procedures outlined in the new TEC Chapter 26A.

Board Action Date:

September 1, 2025

Charters Exempt

Parental Rights Notification

Senate Bill 12

Board Action Required:

An ISD board of trustees must provide to all parents at the beginning of the school year information regarding their rights and options, as specifically dictated in the 15 enumerated items that must be disclosed under TEC § 26.001(d)(4).

Board Action Date:

September 1, 2025

Charters Exempt

Board Training Regarding Parental Rights

Senate Bill 204

Board Action Required:

An ISD board trustee who takes an oath of office prior to January 1, 2026, must complete training related to parental rights, as required by TEC § 11.159(b-2).

Board Action Date:

September 1, 2026
